Job Objective

This is a leadership role, created for someone to take accountability of creating and rolling out a women engagement programme for Shia Islamic centres across the UK, the holder of this role will need to be charismatic, a positive role model for women of all ages, and most importantly be highly driven individual.

Responsibilities & Tasks involve

- Attend monthly Central cabinet meeting/ and weekly Imamiyyah council conference call.
- Work with centre management committees, building trust and gaining their support for women led projects.
- Create a programme and lead the implementation from the front.
- Carry out primary research to understand the main needs of women in our society, and provide proposals to address these.

Time & Travel commitment:

- We require someone who can commit up to 5 hours a week. (Weekdays after 6pm)
- Minimum commitment requested 12 months.
- Willing to travel to centres across the UK for meetings & events (reasonable expenses paid)

Skills & Experience

- Leadership qualities; Confident public speaker, Ability to listen and advise & organized individual.
- Preferably a driver with car required, petrol fully reimbursed.

Performance Measurement:

- Quarterly performance review with Head of Imamiyyah Council & MUS President.
- Weekly progress review over conference call
